Profile	Sherrie Gould, MSN, NP-C, CRMD currently works as a specialty nurse practitioner at the Scripps Clinic Movement Disorders Center in La Jolla, CA where she follows patients with movement disorders includ- ing Parkinson's Disease, essential tremor and dysto- nia.
	In 2025 Sherrie earned her national certification in Movement and Related Disorders (CMRD) as an Ad- vanced Practice Provider in Movement.
	Sherrie Gould NP is currently a sub-Investigator work- ing with Dr Melissa Houser on research which is fo- cusing on genetically matched cell replacement ther- apy for Parkinson's Disease.
	In 2011, in support of the Parkinson's population, she spearheaded a grassroots project to raise funds for a non-embryonic stem cell research project for Parkin- son's Disease. The fundraising for the project has in- cluded a 2011 fundraising climb to the summit of Mt. Kilimanjaro, a 2013 climb to the base camp of Mt. Ev- erest, and another fundraising climb on the Salkantay trek to Machu Picchu. In 2018 she led a group on a pilgrimage on the Camino de Santiago in Spain to empower people with Parkinson's and in 2022 lead a group through the Dolomite mountains in northern It- aly. The Kumano Kodo pilgrimage in Japan was com- pleted in 2024 and plans are being made for a 10-day trek in Bali in 2026. All six climbs have included many patients with Parkinson's and have been fundraisers for Parkinson's research and/or services.

Sherrie co-created the "Parkinson's Boot Camp" that is offered at Scripps Center for Integrative Medicine twice a year. She has been instrumental in the plan and execution of the five-day Parkinson's cruise offered to the Parkinson's community and is instrumental in organizing and speaking at an annual Empowerment for Parkinson's conference held annually in San Diego.

On two consecutive years Sherrie was awarded the Health Hero Award of San Diego for her dedication to the Parkinson's Community. She has also received special recognition by the San Diego Chapter of the California Association of Nurse Practitioners for her outstanding work in the area of Parkinson's disease and her support of research for Parkinson's.

In 2018 she was awarded the Nurse Practitioner of Distinction by the North County Chapter of the California Association of Nurse Practitioners. In 2019 she was the honoree at the annual Parkinson's Association of San Diego Gala

In October, 2023 Sherrie Gould NP was given the "Sherrie Gould MSN, NP-C" award that will be given annually to other NP's and PA's in Movement Disorders that have gone above and beyond traditional role of the Nurse Practitioner.

Sherrie had the honor of receiving the "Kathy Bruyer award" in December of 2024. This prestigious recognition given by the San Diego Parkinson's Association goes to one person a year who has shown dedication and given back to the Parkinson's community in the San Diego area.
